 of the County and State aforesaid Witnesseth that the said John W. Crockett Robert Crockett and
 George Denton and Rebecca Thornton wife forewent in consideration of the sum of Nine hundred Dollars
 to them in hand paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have this day given granted
 conveyed and sold and do hereby convey to the said Richard Forester his heirs and assigns for-
 ever all their right title interest and claim to One league and labour of land situated in the
 Republic of Texas and entered in the name of the heirs of David Crockett his name being three
 eighths of them undivided. Merely thereof after deducting the location part also their entire interest
 in all Army Land in said Republic to which they may be entitled in right of their father
 the said David Crockett on account of his military services in the Revolution which
 terminated in the Independence of Texas being three sixths thereof be it more or less to have
 and to hold the same to the Only proper use benefit and behoof of him the said Richard
 Forester his heirs and assigns forever and the said John W. Crockett Robert Crockett and
 George Denton and Rebecca Thornton wife do Covenant with the said Richard Forester or warrant
 and forever defend the title to said Land against all and every person persons whatever claiming the
 same under any title or pretence whatsoever. In witness whereof they have hereunto set their hands

 Matilda Crockett and One of the heirs of said David Crockett late of the Republic of Texas
 deceased of the One part and Richard Forester of the Other part, all of the County of Tipton and
 State of Tennessee. Witnesseth that the said Thomas D. Tyson and Matilda his wife in Considera-
 tion of the sum of three hundred dollars to them in hand paid by the said Richard Forester the
 receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have this day bargained and sold to the said Richard
 Forester and do hereby convey to him and his heirs and assigns all and singular the rights
 belonging to the heirs of the said David Crockett deceased in the Republic of Texas for his Head-
 right Settlement right and for military services in the late Revolution in Texas to the same
 more or less of which he and he holds the same to the only proper and benefit and behoof of him
 the said Richard Forester his heirs and assigns forever and the said Thomas D. Tyson and
 Matilda his wife do covenant with the said Richard Forester that they will warrant and
 forever defend the title to said Land unto the said Richard Forester and his heirs and assigns
 forever against themselves their heirs and assigns forever and every person persons whatever claiming
 under them and witness whereof We hereto set our hands and affixed our seals the day
 and year aforesaid
